## *Alamo Discovery Tour*

On this one-hour guided tour, an experienced Alamo guide will explain the history of the mission and the fortress and create a memorable educational experience for students. **Available Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 10:30a.m. for school groups up to 60 people.**

Elementary School Student - **\$3 ea.**

Junior High to College Student - **\$7 ea.**

## *Free Church Entry*

A free, self-guided tour of the Alamo Church, Long Barrack, and Alamo Gardens is available during normal operating hours, however, a reservation is required to enter the church. You are free to explore the grounds and visit with living historians for as long as you like. Groups may be asked to divide up to prevent the historic buildings from becoming overcrowded. **Available every day between 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.** (last Church entry at 5 p.m.)

**Exhibit Hall Add-On** : \$5 per person – Self-guided, includes all of the above plus access to the Exhibit Hall to view historic Alamo artifacts. Does not include a guide.

**Audio Tour & Exhibit Hall Add-On** : \$5 per person – Tour the Alamo grounds and Exhibit Hall at your leisure with an audio device with history, sound effects, music, and expert interviews. Available 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. with multiple language options.
