- 1. Legendary co-commander of the Alamo until he fell ill
- 4. Chief engineer of the Alamo
- 5. Last courier to leave the Alamo before the March 6, 1836 battle
- **6.** Died in the battle of the Alamo on his 32nd birthday
- 7. Commander of the Alamo artillery
- 10. This defender's son, Enrique, was an eyewitness of the battle
- 11. One of the Old Eighteen at Gonzales. His wife and infant daughter were present during the battle
- 12. Sheriff for the town of Gonzales and member of the Immortal 32 from Gonzales
- 17. Englishman and commander of the New Orleans Greys at the Alamo
- 18. Nephew of United States president, James Madison
- 19. Legendary frontiersman and former Congressman from Tennessee
- 20. Believed to be the youngest Alamo defender

- **2.** Chief surgeon of the Alamo garrison
- 3. Believed to be the oldest of the Alamo defenders
- 8. Distinguished himself during the siege by burning huts sheltering the Mexican army
- 9. Legend holds this defender played the bagpipes during the siege while Crockett played the fiddle
- 13. Courier who carried the 'Travis Letter' from the Alamo on February 24, 1836
- 14. This defender was born within the Alamo's original footprint
- 15. Graduated from Transylvania University with a law degree in 1834
- 16. Texas commander of the battle of the Alamo
