

What is the purpose of the Phase 2 Archaeology Work for Plaza de Valero?

The Phase 2 Archaeology work is diligently conducted to ensure that no buried cultural resources will be adversely affected by the forthcoming utility relocations, thus preserving the integrity of these invaluable cultural treasures.

Where will the archaeological investigations take place?

Archaeological work will occur throughout the southern portion of Alamo Plaza, Plaza de Valero, and E. Crockett St.

How does this work contribute to the Alamo Plan and the revitalization efforts of Plaza de Valero?

The design of the Plaza de Valero calls for updating the locations of existing utility lines. However, before the digging for new utility lines can take place, the archaeologists will ensure there will be no disturbance of archaeological resources, such as a buried wall foundation or a part of the Acequia Madre de Valero.

When is Plaza de Valero scheduled to be completed?

The project is set for completion in 2024.

When will the project begin and how long is it expected to last?

The archaeological portion of this project is set to begin in early August 2023. Archaeologists will be onsite for the duration of the project.
